#### COURSES TAUGHT AT WARTBURG THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY

Hebrew Bible 1 - Torah (w/ faculty colleague)

Hebrew Bible 2 - Prophets and Writings (w/ faculty colleague)

The introduction to the Old Testament / Hebrew Bible spans two consecutive semesters with an emphasis on critical and faithful engagement with the biblical text interpreted in context: historical, inter-cultural, and theological. Attention is given to developing sound exegetical practices. HB1 focuses on the Torah/Penteteuch. HB2 focuses on Prophets and Writings.

# Creation & Redemption in the Old Testament

This final year HB/OT seminar course is a thematic theological exploration Old Testament texts that narrate/ address creation and redemption, with particular attention to what these texts individually and together communicate about who God is and what God does as well what the way about the individual, the cosmos, and lots of stuff in between.

### Old Testament and Rule of Faith

This final year HB/OT seminar is a biblical-theological exploration of key OT texts and contemporary OT theologies as they relate to – whether with consonance or dissonance — the Rule of Faith (i.e., the Triune confession of God).

# Apocalyptic Imagination

The title of this final year NT seminar, borrowed from John J. Collins' book of the same name, explores apocalyptic literature, biblical and extra-biblical, within an imagination of faith while taking seriously historical origins and contemporary interpretive challenges.

## Reading the Old Testament in the New Testament

This final year NT seminar explores the use of Old Testament texts by New Testament authors with an eye towards interpretative and theological questions that emerge in and around these intertestamental bridges.

# Introduction to Biblical Greek

Basic instruction in Koine Greek - grammar, vocabulary, and syntax - with the goal of empowering students to use Greek in their preaching and teaching.

# Readings in Biblical Theology

A one hour elective centered around collective reading and critical and collaborative discussion of both classic and cutting edge texts in biblical theology.

## Bible, Church, and Film

Using film as "text," this course explores the interpretation / portrayal of biblical texts and ecclesial themes in film. Most films explored in the course come from outside the United States and the immediate orbit of Hollywood.

Jesus Christ and Plural Worlds (w/ Prof. Winston D. Persaud & Dr. Man Hei Yip)

A team-taught required course for first semester, first year seminarians that fosters critical thought and engagement with the basic concept of religion and specific world religions. Students are encouraged to explore what Christians can learn from other religions *and* what Christianity has to say to adherents of other religions / no religion. Basically, why does Jesus matter?

Word, Image, Imagination (w/ faculty colleague)

A team-taught course in the final semester for M.Div. students that provides theological engagement with theories of creativity and imagination in conversation with the creative works of others and that provides students space for nurturing and reflecting upon their own creativity.

## Fascism & Fiction

A seminar that enters the worlds of fascist / totalitarian ideologies as presented in works of fiction in order to explore how faith in Jesus Christ grounds one's understanding of and response to such ideologies.
